



➤ 2001:De-pathologized on LGB in CCMD-3

Guardianship in some cities




Datas about Tongzhi

- ONLY 5% LGBTIQ people are disclosure fully in their life.
- ONLY **5.1%** LGBTIQ people are disclosure in their workplace.
- Over 40% have been suffered school bully on campus.
- Over 97% transgender people has been suffered domestic violence in different forms.
- Nearly 10% LGB people has considered conversion therapy.





Figure 17 "Coming out" of minorities in different daily life environments (%)






